Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) are a group of manufactured chemicals that have been used in industry and consumer products since the 1940s. Due to their widespread production and use, as well as their ability to move and persist in the environment, most people in the United States have been exposed to some PFAS. Current scientific research suggests that exposure to certain PFAS may lead to adverse health outcomes.

This webinar will explore how the waste and recycling industry is addressing PFAS management, from environmental cleanup liability concerns to leachate treatment.
