

# Ready to Receive Funding?

Communities need to take steps to prepare for the launch of the Recycling Modernization Act. CAA is here to help prepare your community for funding.

1

## Primary Funding Agreement

1. Download the fillable PFA from [circularactionalliance.org/oregon](https://circularactionalliance.org/oregon). Fill in the necessary information and email it along with a list of addenda needed and jurisdictions covered to [CAAfunding@millernash.com](mailto:CAAfunding@millernash.com).
2. MillerNash will send the countersigned PFA for your files via DocuSign.
3. Once the PFA is signed, CAA will reach out to discuss the funding stream addenda most critical for launch on July 1 (glass, transportation, USCL depots). After your consultation, CAA will provide a pre-filled, jurisdiction-specific addendum for review and verification.
4. Addenda for additional funding streams can be added later under the same PFA.

## Addenda Prioritization

CAA Oregon will prioritize entities on a first-come, first-served basis with a focus on organizations needing:

- Transportation reimbursement
- Glass collection incentive
- USCL Depot
- System expansion (will be contacted based on market priority A-F)
- PRO depot/Recycling Center (will be contacted by region priority)

## Service Provider Portal

Make sure your organization is prepared to receive funding from CAA. The first step? Sign your PFA.

Beginning in mid-June, CAA will grant access to the Service Provider Portal for organizations with signed PFAs. CAA will email instructions on how to complete the registration process, including where to enter banking details and other required information. Training resources will be provided.

# Funding Addenda Available

## Transportation

Eligible for USCL materials transported over 50 miles from a reload facility to the nearest CRPF with capacity.

Payment will require submission of proof of transport and delivery weights.




## Contamination Reduction

Covers the payment and activities undertaken by, or on behalf of, local governments to comply with the contamination reduction education activities outlined in OTR and the RMA.



## System Expansion

Funding for local government or service providers that need to build the infrastructure necessary for the collection of USCL materials.



## PRO Depot\*

The reimbursement a site will receive for hosting a PRO material collection point, as well as outlining site performance standards.



\*PRO Depots are also called Recycling Centers.

## USCL Depot

Covers costs associated with adding additional materials to an existing USCL Depot to comply with OTR or RMA requirements.



## Glass Incentive

Provides a per-ton incentive for glass collected curbside or at existing glass collection depots. Glass transported over 50 miles from reload to REM is also eligible for transportation reimbursement and requires a transportation addendum.
