About the Tournament and Scholarship Fund

This is a special fundraiser for the Roger W. Emmons Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Roger Emmons was the first Executive Director of Oregon Refuse & Recycling Association (ORRA). He was a key voice in setting solid waste policy in Oregon and a strong advocate of the solid waste industry. Roger passed away in 1986 and was inducted into ORRA's Hall of Fame in 1993.

In 1986, ORRA established the "Roger W. Emmons Memorial Scholarship" in his memory. Every year, ORRA contributes one percent of ORRA regular member dues to the fund. All children or grandchildren of the owner of an ORRA regular member company, or children or grandchildren of an ORRA regular member company's employee (if employed three or more years) are eligible to apply for the scholarship. Initially, the fund was able to award one-time only, \$1000 scholarships. In 1994, a group of members, led by Lowell Kuenzi, proposed holding an annual golf tournament to raise additional funds, with the goal of awarding four-year renewable scholarships. Those funds, coupled with investment earnings, made the goal come true in 1999. With the fund continuing to grow over the years, the scholarship reward amounts have increased as well. In 2017, a "technical scholarship" category was added to encourage students who may not be on an academic track to receive scholarships for more technical post-high school education opportunities. **To date, 131 scholarships have been awarded!**

After the 2019 Tournament, the Emmons Committee discussed whether it was time to honor not only Roger Emmons, but also the other members of ORRA's Hall of Fame who have had important roles in making ORRA the association that it is today. The Emmons Committee recommended the name change to ORRA's leadership, and the Board of Directors agreed that the scholarship will continue to be named for Roger Emmons, and the tournament will honor Roger and all ORRA Hall of Fame members with the new name, **"ORRA Hall of Fame Tournament."**

Finally, in honor of Willie Tiffany, ORRA's Governmental Affairs Director who passed away in 2019, the Emmons Scholarship now gives an extra \$1,000 to a student who is nearing degree completion. This is possible because of the generous gifts made to the scholarship fund in honor of Willie. The first "Willie Tiffany" award was made in 2020, and is given every year.
